<b>4) Safety Issues</b>
GP Surgeries to register with National Reporting & Learning Systems (NRLS) and begin reporting.
Follow up Pregabalin prescribing to ensure dose optimisation and safe quantities of prescribing
MM Team to support practices with MHRA / CAS alerts follow up to patient level where necessary
<b>5) Repeat Prescribing, Repeat Dispensing, Reduction in Medicines Waste &amp; working with Community Pharmacy</b>
Audit of Repeat Prescribing Processes to include demonstration of best practice through Medicines Managers & Receptionist relationships.
Medicines Managers to formalise cost avoidance recording achieved through their management of the Repeat Prescribing Process
Repeat Dispensing - Increase in prescriptions - & work to transfer existing C Pharm repeat patients to RD in preparation of EPS
Consolidation of relationships with C Pharms: One meeting per year to decide on actions to improve relationships / EPS roll out meeting counts.
Continuing medicines waste reduction: Engagement in Reading University medicines waste project. Linked to AHSN.
Quantities management and as per QIPP to include targeted work with Care Homes if a surgery is linked to one. Surgeries without Care Homes to target other relevant therapeutic areas / patients
